**Minutes for the 18<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Steering Committee of Central Adoption Resource Authority (CARA) held on 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2018 at 04:00 p.m. in the Conference Room (Room No. 602) of MWCD at 6th Floor, A-Wing, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi.**

1. The 18<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Steering Committee of Central Adoption Resource Authority (CARA), chaired by Shri Rakesh Srivastava, Secretary, MWCD (Chairperson of the Steering Committee of CARA), was held on 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2018 at 4:00 PM in the Conference Room (Room No.602) of MWCD at 6th Floor, A-Wing, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi.

3. At the outset, Chairperson, Steering Committee welcomed the Additional Secretary, the Joint Secretary (KMH) and all the Members of the Committee and asked Member Secretary & CEO, CARA to start the proceedings of the 18<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Steering Committee of CARA.

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Member Secretary & CEO, CARA welcomed the Chairperson and all the

Members attending the 18<sup>th</sup> Meeting of Steering Committee of CARA. He informed that Minutes of the 17<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Steering Committee held on 15<sup>th</sup> Oct 2018 were circulated to all the Members of the Steering Committee. Since no query/objection has been received from any Member, CEO CARA requested if the same may be taken as approved. All the Members agreed to the same.

5. He informed the Adoption Statistics as on date to the members, copy of which is annexed at **Annexure-II**. He informed that the adoption figure of the year 2017-18 was 3927 as compared to the previous year's figure of 3737. He also informed that from 01.04.2018 till 22.11.2018, 2113 adoptions (In-country 1808 + Inter-country 305) have taken place. He informed that during the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter (Apr-Jun 2018), 916 adoptions took place, in 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter (Jul-Sep 2018) 755 adoptions took place and in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter (Oct till 22.11.18) 442 adoptions have taken place. Further, he informed that 22929 parents are in the waiting list for In-country adoption whereas 852 parents are in the waiting list for Inter-country adoption.

6. As regards Court pendency in the States, CEO CARA informed that there is a long pendency in the States of Bihar (55), Karnataka (51), Madhya Pradesh (40), Maharashtra (153), Odisha (85), Tamil Nadu (46) and Uttar Pradesh (67). He further informed that out of the total 55 pending Court cases in Bihar, 32 cases are more than 6 months old. In one of the cases, the concerned Judge reserved the Judgement but has not issued Order for two months and now one of the Judges of the Bench has been transferred to Chandigarh. Hence, the case will again be taken afresh on constitution of a new Bench. Dr. M. Geeta, Secretary, Govt. of Chhattisgarh also added that she has been pursuing the Courts for issuance of Adoption Orders, personally also, but the case hasn't been disposed of. She intimated that one can only request judges and cannot intervene in the judicial process. CEO CARA informed that he has requested Shri Manoj Arora, PS to Hon'ble Minister and talked to the lawyer also in this regard. He also informed that it was decided

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30<sup>th</sup> Oct 2018 and 1<sup>st</sup> Nov 2018 at CARA & MWCD and Court pendency of all the States were shared with them with the request to intimate the progress by 30<sup>th</sup> Nov 2018. The Committee enquired if they are visiting the States. It was informed to the Committee that the Members who have been allotted West Bengal, Uttar Pradesh, Odisha, Rajasthan and Maharashtra, are more active than other Members. Further, CEO CARA informed that during the last month, 190 Court Orders were issued by the Courts and on an average about 300 Adoption Orders are issued by the Courts every month.

7. *The Committee advised to continue the efforts and keep on writing letters to High Courts informing them about the need of early disposal of the Adoption cases by the Courts in the interest of the children who are waiting for care & protection by the adoptive families. It also advised to request the Advisory Committee Members to interact with the concerned Authorities. They may be requested to approach the RG of High Courts and JJ Committee members of the High Courts to impress upon the need for timely disposal of the Adoption cases as per the provisions of Section 61 of the JJ Act, 2015.*

8. CEO CARA also informed that the as per CARINGS data, the No. of children in SAAs/CCIs as on that day, who were Legally free for adoption were 2102, Children in Need of Care & Protection were 1147 and children yet to be declared legally free were 2303. Further, the No. of new children registered in CARINGS during the month were 389 and No. of children declared legally free for adoption by CWCs in all the States during the month were 207. It was also informed that a total of 211 children (In country – 173 and Inter country – 38) were placed in Pre Adoption Foster Care during the month. As per the CARINGS, 190 Adoption Orders were obtained during the month and 811 Adoption Orders were pending in various Courts of the country. CEO CARA further informed that during the period from 01 Apr 2018 till 22 Nov 2018, a total of 42 Relative Adoptions (In country – 31 and Inter country – 11) and 05 Step Children Adoptions have taken place.

  
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registered, 3469 CCIs have been linked to SAAs and 1581 are yet to be linked. He further informed that the States where number of CCIs yet to be linked is large, are Andhra Pradesh (54) Gujarat (93), Kerala (74), Maharashtra (31), Puducherry (38), and Telangana (104). He further informed that as there are very less children in the CARINGS registered by the SAA/CCIs. State Governments and the Advisory Committee Members have been instructed/ requested to get the CCIs linked to SAAs, however very little progress has been observed in this regard.

10. Chairperson of the Committee informed that there are about 8422 registered CCIs as per ICPS but as per CARINGS it is 5050 and the children available in the SAA/CCIs are also very less (children below 6 years – 250 and above 6 years - 3086) which is of concern. It was also reiterated that in the previous meeting, NIC was directed to update the data of CCI registration and the children in CCIs on CARINGS. Further it was decided that ICPS grant be given only on the basis of the details of children entered on CARINGS.

11. *The Committee advised CARA to get in touch with the ICPS (CW-II Section) to reconcile the same. It was also advised to invite Child Welfare Section in the next meeting. As regards the update on the letters sent by CARA to State Governments on the issue as well as regarding linking of MOC-run-CCIs, it was advised to follow up with them.*

12. Regarding high rate of disruption in adoption, CEO CARA informed that a letter has been issued to the State Governments reiterating them to make the Counselling Centres functional in each District under the direct supervision of the concerned DCPU to assist SAA, CCIs, PAPs, children and other Stakeholders. He also informed that as suggested by AS(AT) during the previous meeting, a Sub Committee has been constituted which consists of Dr. Meena Radhakrishna & Ms. Aparna Bhat, Members of the Steering Committee, and Ms. Vinita Jha, AD, CARA, to study the reasons for the disruption and suggested measures of preventing it. Dr. Meena Radhakrishna

  
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and almost two-third of the cases of In-country Adoption of older children result in disruption. The Committee asked the reason for the disruptions. Dr. Radhakrishna informed that older children have older memories and adoptive families are not prepared to handle them in such a situation. She also informed that she has gone through about 45 files and observed that parents are not given sufficient counseling prior to adoption. She suggested that parents have to be prepared and they should be screened. Adoption through Immediate Placement is not in the best interest of the children and the process may be reviewed. Also the policy of giving immediate referrals to PAPs who have lost their only biological child needs a review as they start comparing the adopted child with their deceased child, resulting in disruption after adoption. Further, language is a big issue, mostly in Maharashtra and Kerala. There are a lot of cultural issues. *The Chairperson advised to please consider it at the time of referral.* CEO CARA told that once the final report is received from the Sub-Committee in this regard, necessary steps would be taken.

13. Action Taken Report (ATR) on the Decisions taken in the 17<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Steering Committee of CARA held on 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2018 were read out and confirmed by the Committee Members. Action Taken Report of the Meeting of Steering Committee held on 15/10/2018 and discussion thereon, is attached as **Annexure-III.**

14. *Further, on the pending issues of Appendix B of the Agenda, the Chairperson advised CEO CARA to get in touch with the Ministry and get the cases finalised.*

### **Agenda Items and Decisions**

#### **Programme Matters:**

##### **Item No. 1: Non-Renewal of Authorization of Foreign Adoption Agency,**

##### **World View Adoption Association, CANADA:**

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15. In accordance with the requirements of Regulation 31 of Adoption Regulations, 2017, Authorized Foreign Adoption Agency namely World View Adoption Association located at 130, Westmore Drive, Suite 5, Toronto, Ontario, M9V5E2, CANADA has applied for renewal of its authorization.

16. The summary statistics concerning adoption (OAS and Relative) of World View Adoption Association, CANADA during the past five years (2013-14 to 2017-18) was submitted before the Steering Committee, which is as under :-

17. It was also informed to the Committee that during the last five years (2013-14 to 2017-18) (Appendix-C attached with the Agenda), seven non-involvement certificates were issued to World View Adoption Association. Out of these seven cases, three non-involvement certificates were issued on the request of the World View Adoption Association. Further, the functioning of this AFAA seems to be unethical and as that of an immigration facilitator through the process of adoption either under Hague Convention or otherwise; as in four cases CARA received the dossiers when the individuals being facilitated for adoption were already adults having crossed the age of 18 years. Further, in one of the case, the adoption of the child was not supported by the Canadian Immigration and the NOC was sought to be cancelled. However, in this case too the child was facilitated in placing with the family through Non-Involvement Certificate. In all these cases, Non-Involvement Certificates were solicited and obtained from CARA which was not provisioned in any Act/Guidelines/Regulations. Here, it has to be mentioned that MWCD, GOI has taken a serious view of issuance of Non-Involvement Certificates and vide its letter no 18-1/2016-CW-II/vigilance dated 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2018, has issued instructions to CARA to prepare the details of such non-involvement certificates issued, based on which children were placed with families in

18. CEO CARA further informed that it has been observed, that a large number of children, especially from Punjab who were 12 years and above, have been immigrated to Canada through adoption process based on pre-dated deeds. Even 20 years olds have been facilitated through 'Non-Involvement Certificates'. Out of the seven Non Involvement Certificates issued, three were issued for adults (i.e. over 18 years of age) on the request of this Agency. Therefore it was decided not to renew the recognition of the Agency. This Agency is writing letters to Hon'ble Minister on daily basis. He also informed that Non Involvement Certificate is not provisioned in any law.

19. The Chairperson pointed out that if the Non Involvement Certificates have been issued by the Authority, then the same be also inquired into.

**Decision:**

20. *The Committee agreed to the decision of non-renewal of the AFAA's authorisation and advised that further inquiry into the issuance of Non Involvement Certificates should be done to see as to why such a certificate was issued for facilitating the placement of adults in Inter-country adoptions.*

**Item No. 2: Delegation of Financial Powers to Joint Director, CARA.**

21. CEO CARA informed that as per Rule 8.2(d) of Rules and Regulations of CARA, 2018, stipulating the Powers of Member Secretary and Chief Executive Officer of CARA, he is further empowered to delegate his powers to the Joint Director with the approval of the Steering Committee.

22. Earlier, the Management Committee of CARA in its meeting held on 23.05.2014 had approved the delegation of the Financial powers up to Rs.15000/- to Joint Director, CARA for approving expenditure on routine/administrative matters (expenditure for procurement of goods/stationery/contingent expenditure/miscellaneous expenditure, etc.) within

the ceiling.

23. Based on the provisions of the Rules and Regulations of CARA, 2018, it was proposed that delegation of following financial powers to the Director/Joint Director, as proposed by CEO CARA, be approved by the Steering Committee:-

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24. He also informed that the delegation of financial powers to the Director/ Joint Director would be subject to the following:-

- (i) The exercise of above mentioned powers shall be subject to the relevant provisions of General Financial Rules (GFR), Delegation of Financial Powers Rules, Receipts and Payments Rules, the Financial Bye Laws/Rules of CARA, Economic Instructions of Government of India and any other relevant orders /notification issued by Government of India from time to time. Joint Director, CARA has also been nominated as Drawing and Disbursing Officer of CARA.
- (ii) Before exercising the financial powers, the Director/ Joint Director will ascertain the availability of the funds under the particular sub-head and the committed liabilities during the financial year.
- (iii) As per Rule 14 of the DDO Manual, The Departments of Central Governments, Administrators and Head of Departments shall have power to declare any Gazetted Officer subordinate to them as Head of Office. In view of this, it is proposed that subsequently after adopting Rules and Regulations of CARA, 2018, and approval of the strengthening proposal of CARA by Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance vide O.M. 870590/2018/E.Coord.1 dated 08.11.2018, Director /Joint Director (whoever is the Senior Most Officer of CARA) after CEO may be nominated as Head of Office (HOO).

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25. CEO CARA informed that we have submitted head-wise delegation of power. He further informed that during the last Steering Committee meeting, we have adopted these Service Bye-laws of CARA. AS(AT) suggested that such type of delegation of power should be moved on file to the Ministry.

**Decision:**

26. *The Committee decided that the proposed delegation of financial power by CEO CARA to Director/Joint Director be moved on file to the Ministry.*

**Item No. 3: Approval of the Steering Committee for draft Annual Report of CARA for the year 2017-2018.**

27. A copy of the draft (English Version) Annual Report of CARA for the year 2017-2018 [excluding Audited Report of DGA(CE)] was placed before the Steering Committee for approval. It was informed to the Steering Committee that as per Section 71(1) of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act 2015, the Authority shall submit an Annual Report to the Central Government in such manner as may be prescribed and the Central Government shall cause the Annual Report of Authority to be laid before each House of Parliament Authority [Section 71(2) of J.J. Act, 2015 refer]. Further, as per Section 69(3)(b) of the J.J. Act 2015, the Steering Committee of CARA shall have to approve the Annual Budget, Annual Accounts, and Audit Reports as well as the Action Plan and Annual Report of Authority. The Annual Accounts for the year 2017-2018 was approved by the Steering Committee in its 15<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 20/06/2018. It was also informed that the DGA(CE), New Delhi has already audited the aforesaid Accounts of CARA and we are awaiting nil Audit Report. On receipt of the same, it will be incorporated in the aforesaid Annual Report and then will be sent for printing. He also informed that Messages for the Annual Report shall be moved on file.

**Item No. 4: Adoption of Recruitment Rules of CARA.**

29. CARA had sent a proposal to the Ministry of Finance, through MWCD duly concurred by IFD, for creation of 19 posts and abolition of 09 posts thereby proposing to increase the total number of Regular posts from 27 to 37. Based on the proposal, Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance agreed for creation of 18 posts and abolition of 08 posts, wherein the sanction strength for 37 Regular posts for CARA has been approved. Sanction Letter of Ministry of Finance is already attached with the Agenda as Appendix-F.

30. In the approval of the above mentioned proposal, up-gradation of post of PS from Level 6 to Level 10 and abolishment of the post of Accounts Officer (Level 7) for creation of additional post of Assistant Director (Level 10) hasn't been agreed upon.

31. Along with the proposal for strengthening of CARA, the draft Recruitment Rules were submitted to the Ministry of Finance, duly concurred by IFD and the Ministry, for the proposed 37 Regular posts. Copy of the same is already attached with the Agenda as Appendix-G.

32. In light of the approval of posts received from the Ministry of Finance, the Recruitment Rules of CARA which has already been approved by the Ministry, is required to be adopted by the Steering Committee under the provisions of Section 69(3)(c) of the Juvenile Justice Act, 2015. Hence, the Recruitment Rules of CARA 2018 were placed at Appendix-H to be adopted by the Steering Committee as the same has already been concurred by IFD and approved by the Ministry.

33. CEO CARA also informed that presently we have 39 outsourced staff which, as per the proposal, would be increased to 56. According to this

proposal, the Senior Professionals would get Rs.65,000, Junior Professionals would get Rs.50,000 and Young Professional would get Rs.35,000 per month. He further informed that as per the discussion with AS(FA), the same would be moved on file to the Ministry.

**Decision:**

34. *The Committee adopted the Recruitment Rules (RRs) at Appendix H of the Agenda after reconciling it with the approved RRs at Appendix G of the Agenda. The typographical errors in Appendix H vis-à-vis the approved RR at Appendix G has been reconciled and placed at **Annexure-IV**. It was further suggested to take immediate action on conducting DPC and publishing advertisement for the regular posts vacant.*

**Item No. 5: Any other item with the approval of the Chairperson.**

**Item No. 5(A) : Photograph of older girl children on CARINGS.**

35. Mrs. Kavita Srivastava, NIC (MWCD) raised the concern of the photographs of older girl children being available on CARINGS for all registered PAPs to view, as most of them are in Immediate Placement category. This policy may be reviewed. CEO CARA said that this point would be considered while the comprehensive review of CARINGS is undertaken.

36. The Meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.



Further, he informed that 22248 parents are in the waiting list for In-country adoption whereas 839 parents are in the waiting list for Inter-country adoption.</p>		


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
	<p>Regarding Court Order pendency, he informed that there is a long pendency in the States of Bihar (62), Maharashtra (36), Odisha (67), Tamil Nadu (67), Uttar Pradesh 53) and West Bengal (148) and the Hon'ble Minister has been receiving letters/emails from such parents. Intervention from the Authority is being undertaken through regular correspondence with the Registrar and JJ Committee of the High Courts as well as State Governments. ## Recruitment Rules of Central Adoption Resource Authority, 2018

### 1. Short Title.

- (a) These rules may be called the '**Recruitment Rules of Central Adoption Resource Authority, 2018**'.
- (b) These rules come into force from the date of it being adopted by the Steering Committee of CARA under the provisions of Section 69 (3) (c) of the JJ Act, 2015.

2. **Application.** These rules shall apply to all 37 posts approved in the Authority by the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Government of India vide ID No. 870590/2018/E.Cood.I dated 08 Nov 2018. The list of approved posts is as mentioned at **Annexure-I** and specified in column 1 of the schedules annexed and to any new post created/upgraded subsequently by the competent authority; and will also be applicable to regular employee of the Authority except otherwise mentioned.

3. **The Number of Posts, Classifications and Scale of Pay.** The number of the posts, classifications and scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in col. Nos. 2 to 4 of the schedules annexed to these rules. **DOPT Guidelines issued by OM no. AB.14017/48/2010-Estt..(RR) Dated 31.12.2010 and OM no AB.14017/13/2013-Estt..(RR) . Dated 31/3/2015.**

4. **Method of Recruitment, Age Limit, Qualification etc.** The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other conditions relating thereto shall be as specified in column Nos. 5 to 13 of the said schedules. (**DOPT Guidelines issued vide OM no. AB.14017/48/2010-Estt... (RR) Dated 31.12.2010, OM no. AB.14017/13/2013-Estt..(RR) Dated 31/3/2015 and Age relaxation for Group-C vide OM No. 14012/1/88-Estt. (D) Dated 30/1/1990**).

5. **General Conditions of Recruitment.** In addition to these recruitment rules, terms and conditions as in the Central Civil Services [Classification, Control & Appeal] Rules, Establishment and Administration Rules, Central Civil Service [Conduct] Rules, Fundamental and Supplementary Rules, Manual of Disciplinary Proceedings, Leave Rules, Manual on Office Procedures, LTC rules, HRA/CCA rules, GFR, DFPR and other rules and orders issued by the Government of India from time to time, shall apply to the officers, staff and establishment of CARA.

### (a) Creation of Posts.

- (i) The posts in Central Adoption Resource Authority shall either be permanent posts i.e. posts carrying a definite scale of pay sanctioned without any limit of time or a temporary post that is a post carrying a definite consolidated pay sanctioned for a limited period of time.
- (ii) Creation and abolition of posts, continuation of temporary posts and conversion of temporary posts to permanent posts in the Authority will be governed in accordance with rules, orders/instructions issued by the Government of India from time to time.
- (b) **Age Limit.** Maximum age limits as prescribed in the Recruitment Rules for appointment to the respective posts shall apply. The retirement age for service in CARA shall be 60 years or as amended by the Central Government from time to time for its employees.
- (c) **Method of Recruitment.** Recruitment to a post in the Authority may be made in accordance with the relevant schedule annexed to these rules
- (i) By promotion; or
  - (ii) By appointment on deputation; or
  - (iii) On short term contract; or
  - (iv) By direct recruitment; or
  - (v) Re-employment
- (d) **Recruitment by Promotion.** Appointment to a post in any grade by promotion shall be made from amongst employees [including officials who have proceeded on deputation and are holding lien in CARA] in the next lower grades [as given in column No. 11 of the schedules annexed] on the method given in column No. 5 of the Schedules Annexed. If a suitable officer is not available for promotion to a post, appointment to that post shall be made by the alternative methods of recruitment as mentioned in relevant schedule.
- (e) **Period of Probation.** Every officer on appointment to the Service, either by direct recruitment or by promotion in Junior Scale shall be on probation for a period of two years, provided that the Controlling Authority may extend the period of probation in accordance with the instructions issued by the Government from time to time.
- (f) **Confirmation.** The confirmation of the officials, if not already confirmed in the entry grade shall depend upon their satisfactory completion of the probation period, failing which their services shall be liable to be terminated at any time without any reasons being assigned for the same.

- (g) **Seniority.** The seniority of employees of the Authority shall be governed by the relevant Rules issued by DOPT from time to time and as applicable to central government employees.
- 6. Disqualifications.** No person who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post, provided that the Controlling Authority may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
- 7. Initial Constitution.** The regular employees already working in the Central Adoption Resource Agency (Autonomous Body registered under Societies Registration Act, 1860) shall continue to be the employees of the Central Adoption Resource Authority [A Statutory Body constituted under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015].
- 8. Consideration of seniors.** Where juniors who have completed their qualifying/eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their Seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying/ eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying/ eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying/eligibility service.
- 9. Appointing Authority.** The Appointing Authority for Group A officers shall be Chairperson of the Steering Committee and CEO CARA for Group B & C officers (Rule 25 of the Rules & Regulations of CARA 2018 refers).
- 10. Power to Relax any Rule.** Where the Authority is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category or persons.
- 11. Saving Clause.** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-Servicemen, and others special category of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
- 12. Assured Career Progression/Upgradation.** The Scheme of Modified Assured Career Progression [MACP] as applicable to Central Government employees or as amended thereon from time to time will be applicable to officers and staff of CARA. If there is no direct line of promotion in the next post, such employees may be considered for next higher scale of pay by way of upgradation.
